

KAMPEON NG KABATAAN AWARDS 2008
(Outstanding Legislators for Youth)

OBJECTIVES:

- To give recognition to legislators from the different local governments for their significant legislations for youth development.
- To create a national databank of legislations for youth development.
- To disseminate outstanding legislations for youth development to all provinces and cities for replication.

MECHANICS:

1. All incumbent vice-governors, vice-mayors, board members, councilors, PCL Presidents, ABC Presidents, SK Presidents are qualified to apply or, be nominated by any Filipino citizen.
2. Relatives of the officials of the National Youth Commission within the fourth degree by affinity or consanguinity are disqualified.
3. The awardees must personally receive their award during the Awarding Ceremony, otherwise it shall be forfeited.
4. Applications or nominations shall be based on legislation principally sponsored by the applicant or nominee during his present or previous terms for the position he is presently occupying. The legislator shall be judged on the basis of his legislation. He can apply or be nominated for different legislations separately.
5. Fact of principal sponsorship should be certified by the Sanggunian Secretary. There can only be one principal sponsor for each legislation. In case there are more than one principal sponsor, the original sponsor shall be considered.
6. The legislation must have been passed and approved as legislation through any process provided in the Local Government Code.
7. The legislator applying for the KAMPEON should attach a briefer on the youth situation of their locality to justify for the need of the passage of that legislation for youth development.
8. Each legislation should have an abstract of the actual impact results of the ordinance since its implementation.
9. All legislations sent should be properly signed by the Mayor to determine whether the ordinance is being enacted.
10. Seven (7) sets of the application/nomination shall be submitted and shall contain the following:
 - a.) application/nomination letter;
 - b.) resume of the applicant/nominee (please see attached form) with 2" by 2" colored pictures;
 - c.) certified true copy of the legislation to be signed by the Sanggunian Secretary;
 - d.) certification by the Sanggunian Secretary that the applicant or nominee is the principal sponsor of the legislation and that the applicant or nominee is an incumbent legislator (position to be specified);
 - e.) video/pictures/documentation of the implementation of the legislation;
11. Use only staple wires to put together documents; do not bind project entries for submission. Do not attach other documents that are not required for submission. When necessary, the Kampeon ng Kabataan Secretariat will request for additional data.

12. Lack or non-compliance of search requirements will result in automatic disqualification.

16. Legislations should be anchored on the 10 point youth agenda stated below.

10 Point Youth Agenda

On Youth Education

1. Enable access to quality and responsive education at all levels
2. Develop Globally competitive youth

On Youth Employment

3. Decrease youth unemployment and underemployment
4. Prevent the exploitation of young workers and working children

On Youth Health

5. Ensure the acceptability, accessibility, availability and affordability of cultural – and gender sensitive and responsive and user-friendly health services and facilities for adolescents and youth, especially in regard to adolescent health and youth development (AHYD)
6. Reduce the adverse effects of risk behavior among Filipino youth

On Youth Participation

7. Strengthen youth participation in community and youth development activities, such as in planning, implementing, monitoring and evaluating youth programs and projects
8. Integrate the youth agenda and concerns in local and national development plans.

On Specific Youth Groups

9. Eliminate all forms of discrimination and abuse against youth

On Youth Values

10 Promote a positive and healthy self-image, critical thinking, love of country, social responsibility and the spirit of volunteerism among youth.

17. Legislations enabling national youth policies and laws are highly encouraged.

18. Ten (10) finalists shall be awarded with plaques of recognition.

Five (5) alternates shall be selected and may replace any of the 10 finalists in case of disqualification for any justifiable cause before the awarding.
